A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE TOWN OF SPRINGFIELD'S APPLICATION FOR A COLORADO PARKS AND WILDLIFE LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION (LWCF) AND GOCO GRANTS TO RENOVATE THE SPRINGFIELD MUNICIPAL POOL, BATHHOUSE, BUILD A MINIATURE PUTT PUTT GOLF COURSE AND SKATE PARK

WHEREAS, the Town of Springfield, Colorado ("Town") owns currently approximately 2.4 acres in size, at 701 W 7th Avenue, between Hill Street &Truman Street in the Agua Addition; and

WHEREAS, the Town is in the planning and design stage of the project; and

WHEREAS, the Town is now seeking grant funding opportunities for the project; and

WHEREAS, the Town has financial resources and is seeking other financial resources from public and private organizations to help with the cash match; and

WHEREAS, the Town is preparing an application for a LWCF grant from the Colorado Parks and Wildlife, and GOCO, and the Board of Trustees wishes to express its full support for both the project, generally, and for a grant application specifically by this resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Springfield, Colorado, as follows:

The Board of Trustees expresses its full support for the project to replace the swimming pool liner, renovate the bathhouse, build a miniature putt putt golf course and a skate park. The Board of Trustees further expresses its support and willingness to fund the long-term maintenance of the project, as well as a statement in affirmation that this land is owned by the Town and forever dedicated to recreational and public use.
